XI. New Business

A. Working Budget FY 2020-2021

- (1) Questions made by Trustee Albert about developer fees, fines & fees due to library being closed, the programming expenses budget, and the Friends of the Frankfort Public Library donations. These budgets will be decreased due to the library closing and slowly re-opening.
- (2) The library will still get the property tax money regardless of the current Stay at Home Order.
- (3) The circulation budget includes a new modular desk and light remodeling for circulation department due to social distancing measures. This was on the remodeling plan and is now funded by the 2020 Per Capita grant.
- (4) Payroll budget will go up due to the minimum wage increase in July.
- (5) Library received a construction grant from the state of Illinois for a new roof.

 Reserve line will not be touched since library did receive the construction grant.
- (6) Question made by Trustee Slovak about the increase of IMRF budget. Question made by Trustee Albert about the June janitorial check, Pierre will look into renegotiating the contract for that month. Question made by Trustee Look about professional training, this will be looked at again in the June meeting. Motion made by Trustee Look to approve the 2020-2021 Working Budget as amended. Seconded by Trustee Labuda. All trustees voted "Aye." Motion carried.

B. COVID-19 Re-Opening Plan

- (1) Melissa Rice presented to the Board about the COVID-19 Re-Opening Plan. It will take a week of prep work to re-open and re-organize offices due to social distancing measures.
- (2) Phase 1 will start June 9 and includes touchless pick-up for patrons while using the Curbside Communicator software provided by SWAN. There will be limited staff working in the library while the rest continue working from home. Library will start picking up items from homebound patrons and nursing home patrons and will quarantine these items for seven days. If a staff member or their family is diagnosed with COVID-19, the library will have to be shut down for two weeks.

- (3) Questions made by Trustee Albert about when interlibrary will start and employee temperature checks. Melissa answered that it is unclear of when RAILS will restart interlibrary loan and confirmed that employees will receive a temperature check upon entering the building. Question made by Trustee Levya about whether library can do a Five-Phase plan like Illinois rather than a Four-Phase plan. Melissa answered that more phases will be added on if needed. Motion made by Trustee Look to approve the COVID-19 Re-Opening Plan. Seconded by Trustee Labuda. All trustees voted "Aye." Motion carried.
