Additions might also include how many homebound patrons there are, and how many homes are visited. She also recommended adding statistics about programming attendance and the summer reading programs under what the library has done well (section 9). Trustee Look recommended adding the service of meeting rooms and study rooms as a space for teens to study during final exams twice each year.
