# VI. New Business

- A. Policy Review
  - 1. Security Camera Policy- Reviewed similar policies from other libraries, which were identical to the current Frankfort policy. Upon review no changes recommended.
  - 2. Artwork Display Policy- Some of the procedure presented in this policy does not reflect our current procedures, such as the creation of an Art Review Committee. Planned to make changes to more accurately reflect current procedures and eliminate some repetition in the policy. Suggested change of giving 14 days to pick up art following a display, instead of the current 30 days.
  - 3. Borrowing Privileges Policy- Our current policy does not include anything beyond who and how a person can get a library card. After reviewing policies from area libraries, the decision was made to add additional information about reciprocal borrowing, lost and damaged material, overdue fines, among other important circulation rules. Other suggested revisions include removing the replacement cost of a lost or damaged library card and removing a reference to card expiration, since we no longer expire cards. A full draft will be made for the next Policy & Personnel Committee Meeting.
