Schedules of Genealogy: <u>Genealogy Starts with You!</u>

- Start with yourself and work backwards in time.
- Start with what you know and then move into the unknown.
- Sonnect each generation to the previous one to make certain you are claiming the correct ancestors.
- Sontact as many living relatives as possible.
- Secure vital statistical information.
- Solution from a number of sources (b/c your goal is to get the best possible information).
- Site/document your sources as you record information.
- Stay organized from the beginning.
- Strink LOCAL, LOCAL, LOCAL
- Seep an open mind.
- While conducting research at or corresponding with other relatives, government institutions, archives, libraries, museums and so forth...remember to:
 - Make responding easy.
 - Not ask for too much at once.
 - Ask for specific information on specific people.
- Son't lose sight of the big picture and the supreme values of genealogy.
- Se careful not to become territorial about the subject or your research.
- Se in tune with coincidences, synchronicities, and serendipitous occurrences.
- Remember, anything worth it many times takes a lot of effort.
- Sou will never be finished with your genealogy; genealogy can be a lifelong endeavor.
